### WHAT?

Students will do a literary analysis for a classic work of literature. They will develop annotation skills, improve reading comprehension and work on synthesizing their knowledge into written works. Students will also work on timed reading comprehension strategies and timed writing components to prepare for the rigors of high school and college entrance academic testing. Students will learn how to write an “A” high school paper.
